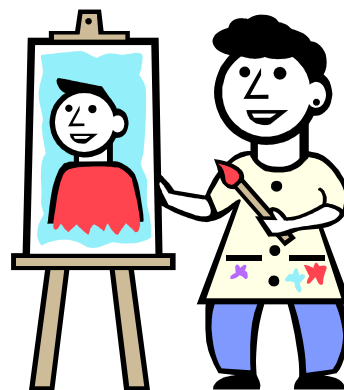

We stay in small hotels, guest houses, B&Bs and occasionally castles. All rooms are en suite twin, double or single. Singles are available for a small supplement. Terms and conditions

2. If you are prevented from proceeding, you may transfer your booking to any other appropriate person free of charge, provided that you give reasonable notice before the departure date and that there are no other changes to the booking details.
3. A booking is accepted with payment of a deposit of US\$600 / EU€450 / UK£400 per person. On receipt of this you will receive a letter of confirmation.
4. The final balance is payable eight weeks before departure. If it is not paid by this date, we reserve the right to cancel the booking.

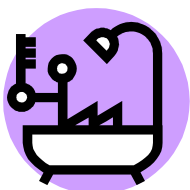
